

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SEASON

The Association's swimming season will normally run from Saturday of Memorial Day weekend through the second Sunday after Labor Day. The tennis courts will be open year round.

HOURS

Swimming hours will be 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. except under special circumstances, in which case the membership will be given reasonable notice. When Montgomery County Public Schools are in session, pool hours will be shortened, with specific hours to be posted at the pool office and listed in the spring mailing to members.

During the swimming season, the tennis courts will be unlocked one-half hour before the pool opens. Members wishing to use the courts at other times may obtain the combination for the tennis and road gate locks. Members are responsible for locking the courts when play is concluded and no others are playing, and for locking the road gate if they are the last to leave the property. The combination may not be offered to guests.

GENERAL OPERATING RULES

1. The pool manager is authorized to enforce all rules relating to health and safety. He/she may eject any person from the pool, tennis courts, or surrounding grounds for failure to comply with any rules regarding health, safety, or peaceful enjoyment of the facility.
2. The Association is not responsible for articles of clothing and other personal property that have been lost or stolen. Articles found on the premises, except wallets and other identifiable objects, will be kept outside the guard's room for at least one week and then discarded. The Association does not assume responsibility for any injury, accident, or property damage in connection with the use of any part of the facility.
3. The pools and tennis courts may be closed when necessary for maintenance or for special events. Reasonable notice of such closing will be given to the membership by means of posted notices at the office and in the annual calendar.

4. All swim and tennis lessons will be scheduled to interfere as little as possible with the general use of the facility.
5. The pool will be made available, at times, for special community programs operated by the Association and approved by the Board and appropriate agencies of Montgomery County.
6. For purposes of administering these rules and regulations, an adult is defined as an individual 15 years of age and older.
7. No pets are allowed anywhere on the Association property.
8. Trash containers for all paper and other throwaways are provided, and should be used.
9. No person shall use the pools outside of operating hours and only when guards are on duty.
10. Limits on guest privileges may be imposed on a given day if the facility becomes so congested that its use by the membership is hindered.
11. Glass, in any form, is not allowed anywhere on the property.
12. All eating and drinking is to be done in the picnic area and the tables on the deck. No food or drink other than water is allowed on the pool decks.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

1. All adult members must show a membership card as they sign in to enter the pool. All children must show one his/her family cards.
2. Members arriving at the pool without a card will be asked to show a photo I.D. which will be cross referenced to our current membership list.
3. Children 8 to 14, i.e., those who have passed their eighth birthday but not yet reached their fifteenth birthday, may come swimming alone provided:
 - a. They have passed the basic swimming test, which shall consist of:
 1. Swimming one length of the main pool with confidence, and

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2. Treading water for one minute.

The pool manager or his/her delegate shall be the sole determiner of the successful completion of the test.

- b. They have permission from their parents or guardians on file at the office stating that they may come alone.
4. Children under 8 years of age, regardless of their swimming proficiency, must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult (15 years of age or older) inside the pool areas.
5. Child-care providers, when attending member's children, may use the pool without charge provided written permission from the member is in hand or on file at the pool office. Childcare providers must be 15 years of age or older.
 - a. Only two names of two child-care providers may be on file at any given time.
 - b. Only one child-care provider will be allowed free access to the pool at any one time.

GUESTS

1. Members may bring guests to the pool during operating hours and to the tennis courts when open. Members must register their guests at the pool office and remain in attendance on the Association's property during the entire time the guest is on the property.
2. The Association charges guest fees on a daily basis, which entitles the guest to use all of the Association's facilities on that day.
3. Guest fees must be paid upon registering the guest at the pool office. Payment can be made by check payable to the Association or by using a "guest card" which may be purchased at the time of the annual dues payment or from the pool office during operating hours. Direct payment of guest fees at the pool office, or for a "guest card" can only be made by check. No cash will be accepted by the pool office as payment under any circumstances.

4. Guest cards contain 18 "punches" and cost \$18. The card does not expire at any time.
5. The amount of the guest fee varies depending on the age of the guest and whether the guest visits the Association property on a weekend or a weekday. The fee schedule is as follows:
 - a. Children: \$2 or two punches on weekdays; \$4 or 4 punches on weekends.
 - b. Adults (age 15 and over): \$4 or 4 punches on weekdays; \$6 or 6 punches on weekends.
6. All guests are subject to the same behavior standards and regulations which govern members. Members are responsible for apprising their guests of the safety, health, and general conduct rules and will be held responsible for actions of their guests.

SHOWER AND DRESSING AREAS

1. All persons are required to shower before entering the pools and to wash their hands after using the toilets.
2. Young children should be attended by responsible adults when using the bath facilities. The adults are responsible for misuse of these facilities and may be required to clean or repair misused facilities. Children should be reminded of the need to turn showers off after use.

TENNIS COURTS

1. All players, including guests, must sign in at the tennis courts before playing.
2. Play on the courts will be governed by the rules of the U.S. Tennis Association unless otherwise indicated. Standard rules of tennis etiquette must be observed at all times.
3. The area within the fence enclosing courts is restricted to players only. Children not engaged in tennis play shall not be permitted on the courts at any time. No strollers, bikes, roller blades or other objects which may damage the court surface shall be allowed within the fenced area.
